| Acacia baileyana | Cootamundra Wattle | A small tree or large shrub with attractive glaucous foliage and masses of fluffy yellow flowers. | Evergreen | 5m |
| Acacia baileyana purpurea | Purple Wattle | The purple new growth makes an attractive contrast to the greyish older foliage. A mass of rich yellow flowers in spring. Fast growing, likes dry conditions. | Evergreen | 4.5m |
| Acacia dealbata | Silver Wattle | Dainty silvery green fern-like leaves. Clusters of scented, fluffy golden balls in early spring. | Evergreen | 6-8m |
| Acacia floribunda | White Sallow Wattle | Very fast growing bushy small tree with graceful weeping branches and yellow flowers in early spring. Hardy. | Evergreen | 4m |
| Acacia melanoxylon | Blackwood | A fast growing good timber wattle. Average for frost, very attractive. Suits a hot climate with average moisture. | Evergreen | 10m |
| Acacia pravissima | Ovens Wattle | Upright growth with small triangular blue-green leaves on slender branches. Bright golden flowers from spring through to summer. | Evergreen | 3m |
| Acer capillipes | Snake Bark Maple | A small tree with striated bark, young growths coral red. Attractive autumn colouring. | Deciduous | 5m |
| Acer cappadocicum aureum | | Young leaves red, turning golden yellow and remaining so for many weeks before changing to light green. Rich gold autumn colours. | Deciduous | 7m |
| Acer davidii | Pere David's Maple | This small tree with green and white marbled bark has shining dark green leaves colouring richly in autumn. Green fruits flushed red hang along branches in autumn. | Deciduous | 4m |
| Acer Esk Flamingo | | Very spectacular maple with graceful weeping habit. Best display in summer and autumn when leaves are mottled with showy pinks and creams. Hardy. | Deciduous | 3m |

| Cornus alba | Red-barked Dogwood | Forms a thicket of stems up to 3m high, young branches being rich red in winter. Good autumn colour. White or tinged blue berries. | Deciduous | 3m |
| Cornus alba Elegantissima | | A very hardy, red-stemmed dogwood. Broadly margined and mottled leaves. Very cold hardy and easy to grow. | Deciduous | 2m |
